7. May Show Updates
  - a. Food vendor – Rachel is good with making breakfast and lunch (8-10 breakfast, 11-2 lunch) Germaine will share costs and with signs that ask for \$7 – Rachel will confirm pricing) Mom mocktail bar – with a BYOB.
  - b. Rachael has her people to announce in the small ring Saturday. Terry will cover back gate for Hunter’s on Saturday and Jumpers on Sunday. Christy will relieve so Terry on Sunday so that she can show. Jumper day is outdoors.
  - c. Idea to have a “mom” lead line class in the indoor Saturday. Let’s make it FREE to enter. Christy will donate the prize for the mom class – split bottles of bubbles.

- d. Judges: Amy Gau and Julia Mattson will judge Saturday, Bob Widmayer will judge Sunday.
  - e. Christy will make signs for the food this weekend and Selena will send Christy information for signs to promote the July event.
8. Summer Event Updates – July 19
- a. Germaine ordered ribbons – coming from Washington
    - i. Prizes: Coolerettes orders
    - ii. Suggested Swag Bag: hats, mugs, towels, horse cookies, equifuse products
  - b. Vendor: Booths for Equifuse, Absolute Horse, Horse Guard, Jolie Marchet
  - c. Germaine has donated \$1000, Charlotte \$500, Terry \$500, Christy \$500, Nicole \$250, we need \$250 more to round out the cash prizes.
  - d. Judges – might have some guest judges from out of town and/or trainers will create a panel.

  - k. Christy will follow up with Maci on getting HDHJA branded cookies for dessert.
  - l. Nicole handling bar: beer wine and a signature cocktail with two liquor options and a non-alcoholic option for charge - \$1500 minimum that HDHJA will be responsible for if we don't hit the limit. Includes a cart – turnkey.
  - m. Tent: 20'x40'. Six round tables that seat chairs 8, 2 8' rectangular tables for food.
  - n. Christy will do centerpieces if HDHJA will cover the cost - \$200
  - o. Do we have a medic? Germaine will investigate.
  - p. Committees for set up/tear down and check in. We will have a wrist band to ensure check in.
  - q. We can use the HDHJA back drop for a selfie/photo op
  - r. Parking attendant for cars and trailers
