1. Call to order at 6:37pm
2. Roll call: Germaine, Terry, Christy, Rachel, Moseley, Charlotte, Lisa, Jen, Nicole, Margaret, Kalie, Selena, Grace, Kay
3. Approve minutes: Terry moves to approve, Margaret seconds, no abstentions.
4. Website update – Christy gave a quick demo on what the new website looks like, the new navigation, and what’s still left to complete before launch.
5. Treasurer’s report/tax return & annual return status HDHJA account has \$68+k, KG account has \$6+k
 - a. Discussion around how much money we can legally have in our account at any given time, we believe it to be \$100k – so we are ok here.
6. Finalize date for June show
 - a. June 6-7 – Rachel’s barn is hosting a clinic, but this weekend works for Sydney’s group.
7. High Desert Classic/Summer Event
 - a. We discussed running a HDHJA show concurrently with the Classic. Questions around participation and costs resulted in a no go. We think riders will not be able to show at both.
 - b. Stand Alone Summer Event – July 18 or 19 – one day event, three classes with a catered lunch, beverages and entertainment. Format and location to be discussed further.

- c. Selena agrees to take this on with Germaine to determine logistics and details for a stand-alone event in July.
8. Information for judges

New this year – rules for schooling: (the details have not yet been worked out and this has not yet been approved)

 - i. There is a limit of four horses in the ring warming up at the same time.
 - ii. All riders must go the same direction. The announcer will announce a change of direction about every five minutes.
 - iii. There will be one single fence on the quarter line and one line on the side available for warm-up. No other jumps will be permitted to be used.
 - iv. A good compromise here is to block off one diagonal line and limiting the number of horses to four in the ring at once. That way we eliminate cross traffic on the diagonal lines.
 - v. Terry will add something about attire, that schooling attire is acceptable.
 - vi. We are going to split the lower division classes (poles/cross rails only) between adults and children. If we have a large class where we can easily split adults from kids to keep things fair, we pin them separately.
9. Hoods – this pertains to clothing. No jackets with hoods are allowed in the show ring.
10. New Business - Donated clothes, Christy and Germaine to look through and see if anything of value is worth selling on marketplace. What's left will be given away at the first show.
